Continuously building on each of the **17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**, The Parkside is also the first urban hotel in the world to become a member of **Beyond Green**, a diverse portfolio offering a range of guest experiences in unique locations around the world, focused on intentional travel.

Keenly aware of how tourism can impact nature, community and culture of a destination, The Parkside Hotel & Spa team has worked hard to lesson the footprint, achieving third-party certifications, demonstrating a commitment to the core. **5 Key, Green Key Global** rated and member of **TripAdvisor's GreenLeaders** programme, the hotel began measuring greenhouse gas emissions (GHG) in 2016 and continues to do so each year with Synergy Enterprises.

Signing the **Sustainable Tourism Pledge 2030** and advocating for all hotels in Greater Victoria to join the pledge, The Parkside Hotel & Spa works to inspire positive impact, uniting fellow hoteliers and creating a sense of place with long-term planning.

Following the principle of raising awareness through education, The Parkside Hotel & Spa educates guests, staff, and others, advocating to preserve the natural and cultural heritage of the community.
