

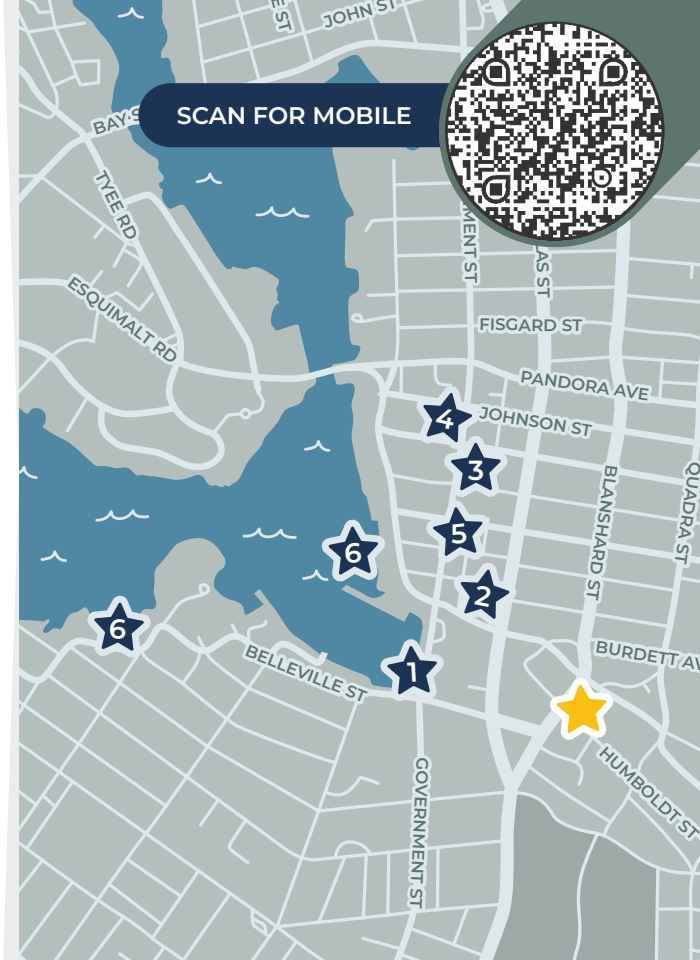

Sidney Whale Watching is an Indigenous, family-owned and operated company that has been serving Sidney and the Saanich Peninsula for over 20 years. They offer daily whale watching trips, culinary tours on the Gulf Islands, and charters for private events.

We acknowledge and respect the lək̓ʷəŋən peoples on whose traditional territory The Parkside Hotel & Spa stands and the Songhees, Esquimalt and W̱SÁNEĆ peoples whose historical relationships with the land continue to this day.

The hotel opened in 2009 with a focus on environmental actions and in 2021, the hotel started the steps to reconciliation with the Songhees Nation. The Parkside Hotel & Spa is the first hotel in Greater Victoria to work towards signing a Memorandum of Reconciliation (MOR), becoming friends with the Songhees.

In 2024, our Climate Contribution Fee was adjusted to include additional funds directly supporting the Indigenous Tourism Association of Canada.
